ACTUARY REPORT:

Mr. DuLaney reported that they prepared a pre-retirement in service death benefit to the surviving spouse of Officer Rugerio Morales. Ms. Morales will be receiving a monthly benefit in the amount of \$2,433.76 effective 2/1/11.

ATTORNEY REPORT:

Officer Morales was coming off shift at 7:00 am after the Special Response Team training and was warming up at approximately 9:00 am. Officer Morales ran ½ mile the obstacle course and collapsed and suffered a heart attack. Davie fire rescue administered CPR until Sunrise Fire rescue arrived at the scene and transported Officer Morales to the hospital. Mr. Levinson reported that the Board pending receipt of death certificate will be granting 50% of base pay be paid to the surviving spouse and that the actuary has prepared a pre retirement in service death benefit. Trustee Mackie moved to approve the benefit and Trustee DiMeglio seconded the motion and it passed 4-0.
